



# Summer Camp Creation 2010

## Full Day Age 7 - 14

### Program Description:

This is a week-long, 9am - 4pm program (9 weeks offered):  
Each week consists of one large project that takes the whole week to complete and a number of small projects that are different every day

- The week-long project, for which the schedule is listed in the "Large Project Schedule" on the next page, takes the entire week to complete, and is the main focus of the week. Each child designs their own version of the project.
- The smaller projects are chosen from the large selection of media listed below. The time allotted for smaller projects determined by the time the large project takes. Each camper will design their own Camp Shirt, and decorate invites to the art show.

### Lunch-time:

- At lunch time, we walk, "en-masse", to Young's Field Park (approx. 5 min.) where the kids eat, play in the playground, read a book, face paint each other, have water gun fights and/or relax under a tree.

On the way home, we go for ice cream (see "Optional" on page 3). Time and parents permitting; during the week we will also take optional mini field trips to local downtown shops, as well as VCA's Art Supply Store.

Parents can provide additional money for purchases if desired.

(All shops located within a 2 min. walk of the VCA).

## Parent Checklist:

1. Welcome to Summer Camp Creation 2010!!!
1. Please go over your child's allergies with us when you arrive the first day.
2. Send your children in **CLOTHES & SHOES THAT CAN BE DIRTIED!!!!!!!**
3. We require **prompt drop off BY 9:00 AM and pick-up AT 4:00 PM**, unless pre-arranged for early/late pick/drop off.
  - a. Unless pre-arranged with front desk, **NO ONE LEAVES BEFORE CLEAN-UP.**
4. If early or late parent pick-up required:
  - a. We need to know at start of week if possible. (Fee will be incurred for late p/u.)
  - b. If child is sick one day, **PLEASE call us, so we don't wait to start, 354-4318!!!!!!!**
  - c. **If your child is sick or tardy: Due to the nature of this camp program, missed days due to illness or any other obligations, cannot be "made up" at another time. Extreme cases will need to be discussed on a case-by-case basis.**
5. Please have your child pre-lotioned with sunscreen lotion EACH DAY, despite forecast.
6. Lunch:
  - a. Please provide a backpack so your child can transport his/her lunch to the park.
  - b. We expect them to eat... and will check before they play. Please tell us your expectations. If you do not require us to check if they've eaten, please tell us!!
  - c. Please provide extra water for drinking.
  - d. We may not go to the park every day due to inclement weather or the need to complete projects. This will be determined on a day to day basis.
7. Water Play: (Participation is up to your child)
  - a. Water gun & Extra water for gun refills.
  - b. Bathing suit (if no, change of shorts and undies) & Towel
  - c. Water shoes of some sort, (Mandatory!!!! Children MAY NOT go barefoot in the park, thanks to those "citizens" who enjoy breaking bottles in the park).
8. Theme Days:

To help your child prepare for the theme days, here are some tips:

  - a. Tues.: **Crazy Hair Day** Go Wild! Color, objects and/or younger siblings in hair, be creative.
  - b. Wed.: **Bring a real pet day**, (if allowed). Parent must stay till 9:20 to take pet home.

Your child may "Invent a Pet" and bring it in, ie..pet rock, pet stick, favorite stuffed animal, picture of their real pet. ONE pet per person please.
  - c. **"Way Out" Artist Day**....Go wilder, clothes, hair, hat, anything you can think of.
  - d. **Camper's Choice Day** Campers will discuss and decide what this Day will be when they do their "meet and greet" on Monday morning.
9. Please give your child's Ice Cream Money to the front desk.

### Class Trips:

Parents will be advised days of field trips. Parents can choose whether their camper can go and then provide them with money to spend.
